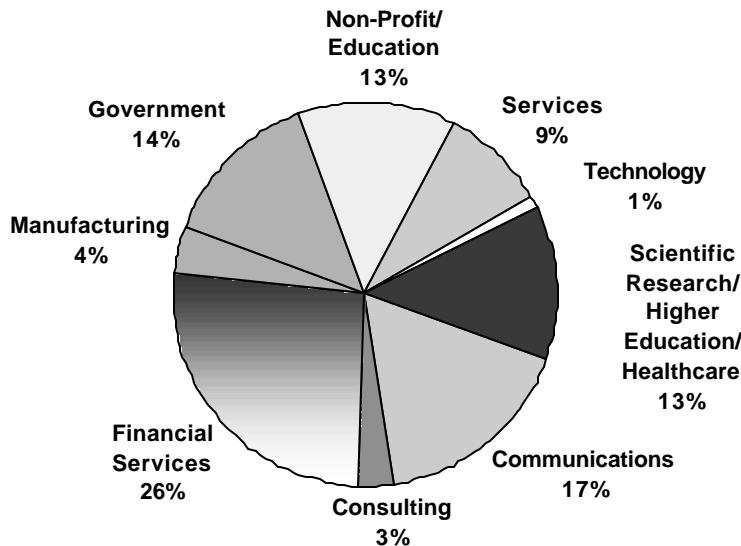

#### Distribution by Industry



Students responding to the survey worked in 53 different industries, performing 78 different job functions.

While the summer survey is an annual survey, significant trends can be seen by examining the differences between Summer 2000 and 2002.

While distribution by industry group (see figure on left) remains largely unchanged, we see an 8% increase in internships in government and a 5% decrease in technology internships. This is consistent with national economic trends and interests.

Despite the continued national economic downturn, this year's salaries remained steady: our monthly salary for full-time interns increased 6% (\$128) to \$2,266.

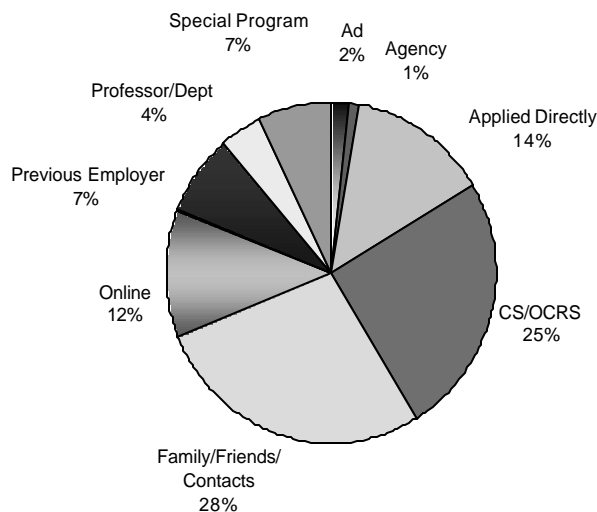
In comparison to the 2000 Summer Survey, we found:

- Notable increases in salary for positions in Financial Services (24%), Manufacturing (21%) and Government (15%)
- Decreases in salary in Communications (22%) and Consulting (-19%) related positions.

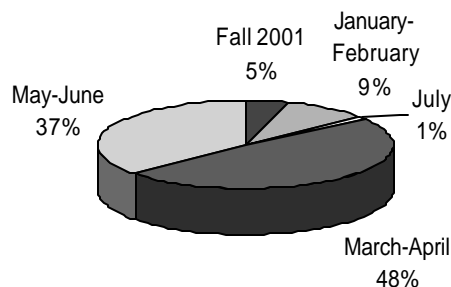

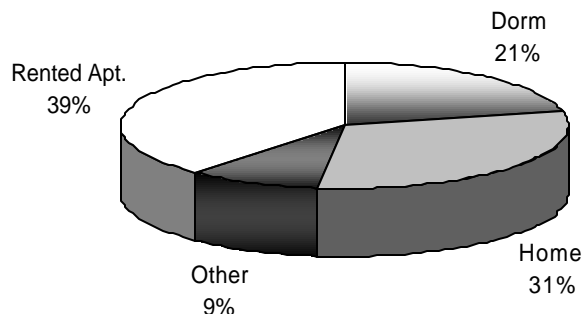
