Friends of World Teaching Vacancies Lists (2002)

This list contains contact information for schools in Australia, Fiji, China, Italy, Germany, Chile and Mexico.

International Schools Directory (2000-2001)

This directory provides comprehensive information on the leading English-medium schools throughout the world. There are over 530 ECIS (European Council of International Schools) listed with full details including contact details, enrollment, ages, curriculum and examinations, and a description of the facilities. An additional 484 international schools are listed with brief details,

The ISS Directory of International Schools (1996)

A comprehensive guide to K-12 American & International Schools Worldwide. It is arranged alphabetically, by country, then city or town, and finally school name.

International Education Guide (2000-2001)

This directory contains listings for language schools in Belgium, France, Germany, Spain, the United Kingdom, and the United States.

Schools Abroad of Interest to Americans

This directory contains listings for schools in Mexico and Central America, the Middle East, South America, Asia and the Pacific Islands, Australia and New Zealand, Canada, the Caribbean Islands, Europe, and Africa.

CAREER INFORMATION

The CELT (Careers in English Language Teaching) GUIDE (2001)

This guide is divided into four sections: Training, Working in the U.S. and Canada, Working Around the World, and Career Development. The training section provides an overview of courses available in U.S., Canada and other countries in addition to information on funding. The section on working in U.S. and Canada discusses the opportunities that are available in North America to teach English as a second language. The third section contains resources on finding employment abroad and the Career Development section contains resources for experienced educators. The appendix contains a list of addresses for schools, bookstores, and U.S. embassies around the world.

Teaching English Abroad, Susan Griffith (2001)

An excellent resource that provides information on training, finding a job, preparing for a position abroad, and potential issues such as culture shock. The book also contains a country by country guide and includes Western Europe, Eastern Europe, the Middle East, Africa, Asia and Latin America.
