

WHAT IS THE FACILITIES MANAGEMENT FEE?

The Facilities Management Fee is assessed to the non-residential members of fraternities and sororities to support the operational budget for the Chapter House. Though the students are not necessarily residents of the property, the Chapter House is the physical manifestation and visible representation of the Chapter on campus. The house is used by all members formally and informally, and the upkeep of the exterior and common areas of the property is the responsibility of every member of the Chapter. The revenue from this fee supplements the actual operating budget of the house and supports items like cleaning, grounds & maintenance, life safety mechanisms, and liability insurance. The amount of the fee varies from chapter to chapter, depending on what is to be funded by the fee, and is set by the Chapter student leaders and the Alumni House Corporation each year during the budget planning process.
